All RAT-SAR members are responsible for acquiring their own personal gear. All RAT-SAR members responding to callouts must have a SAR pack capable of 24-hour sustainment in the field.

## **SUGGESTED MEMBER SAR PACK (non-technical)**

### **Survival Gear:**

- Signal Mirror
- Ferro Rod, Matches, Lighter
- Paracord (30')
- Pocket Knife / Multi-Tool / Saw
- Survival Blanket
- Rescue Whistle

### **Sleeping / Shelter**

- Sleeping Pad (Foam)
- Sleeping Bag (Season Dependent)
- Tarp and/or Bothy Bag

### **Cooking:**

- Gas Stove
- Spoon
- Food / Snacks
- Metal Cup

### **Nav Pouch:**

- GPS w/ Batteries
- Compass
- Notepad
- Grid Readers
- Pencil

### **Lighting:**

- Headlight (2 ea.) w/ Extra Batteries
- Chem Lights (2 ea.)

### **Clothing (suited to environment):**

- Rain Jacket (Goretex Shell)
- Extra Socks
- Extra Shirt
- Bandana

### **PPE**

- Gloves
- Helmet
- Safety Glasses

### **Miscellaneous:**

- Water Purification Tabs or Filter
- Minimal First aid kit
- Water Container(s)
- Large Contractor Garbage Bag
- Duct Tape (Small Roll)
- Sewing Kit / Mini Repair Kit
- Flagging Tape

### **Communications:**

- Handheld Radio w/ Spare Battery (Supplied by RAT-SAR as needed)

### **Cordage / Rope / Carabiners**

- 15' of 1" Webbing
- 6-7mm Prusik Cord, 48" long
- Locking Carabiner, 22 kN minimum (2 ea.)
